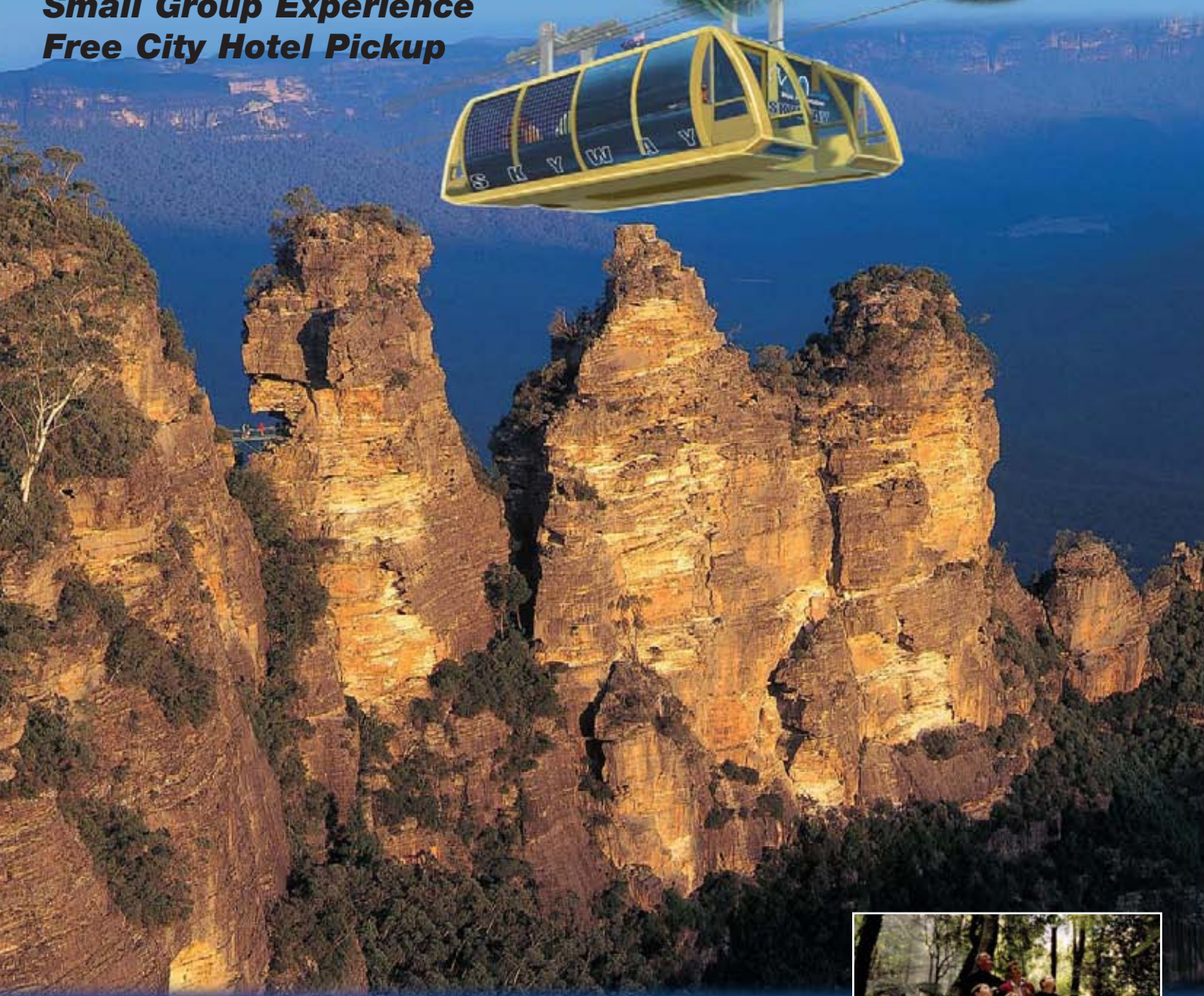

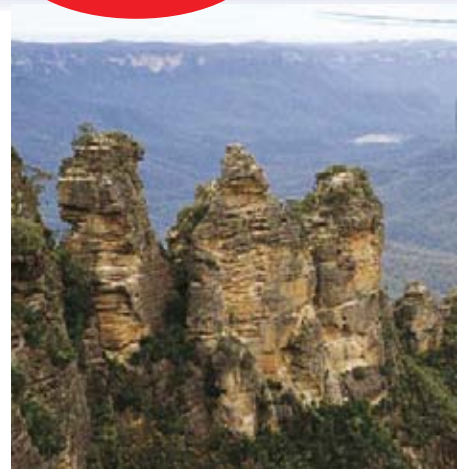
LUNCH OPTIONS:

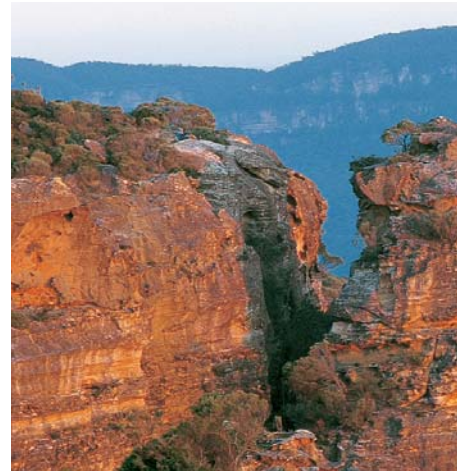
Tour 6L. Include lunch in a licensed Katoomba restaurant – Roast of the Day, a delicious Buffet or Vegetarian is catered for.

- Ride the **Skyway Cable Car*** across the valley in front of the **Katoomba Falls**. Descend down on the world's steepest **Scenic Incline Railway*** to the canyon older than America's Grand Canyon. Meander along the elevated timber **boardwalk** under the picturesque ancient rainforest canopy. Walk past the coal-mines and smell the eucalyptus trees, home of many exotic birds, returning up by the **Flyway*** cable car passing the **Orphan Rock** and **Katoomba waterfalls**.
- With many **bushwalks** available the most popular is the boardwalk at the bottom of the **Jamison valley**.
- See **Australia's Grand Canyon**, waterfalls, rainforest, rugged gorges and of course the blue.
- Only our **small tour groups** can visit the spectacular **Cahill's Lookout** to view the **Boar's Head**.
- See the **mountain devil** which changes from a flower into the **devil!**
